

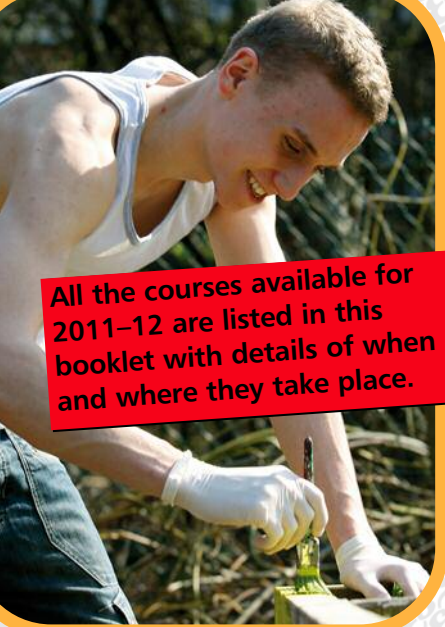

Available at all campuses. An interactive step-by-step guide on how to prepare for and pass the driving theory and hazard perception tests.

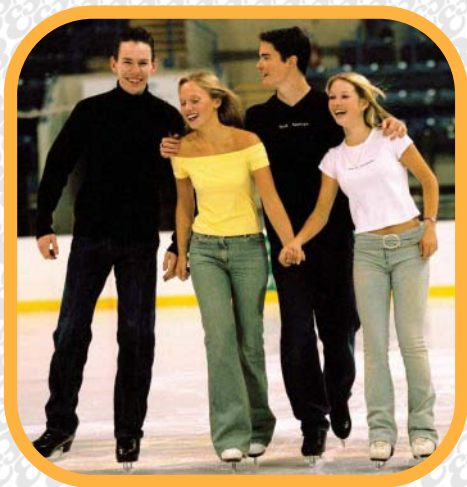
No previous experience necessary.
